

MECHANISM OF GRADE DISTRIBUTION FOR ACADEMIC SUBJECTS

College of Physical Education and Sport Science / University of Anbar

Based on the nature of the approved academic subjects in the College of Physical Education and Sport Science, and for the purpose of unifying the foundations of evaluation and measurement for students, the grade distribution mechanism is adopted as follows:

FIRST // PRACTICAL SUBJECTS:

The final grade for the practical subject shall be **(100)** marks, distributed as follows:

• **1. Year's Coursework (Sae'e): (50) marks**

- Practical Side: (30) marks.
- Theoretical Side: (20) marks.

• **2. Final Examination: (50) marks**

- Practical Exam: (30) marks.
- Theoretical Exam: (20) marks.

Accordingly, the total marks for the practical side shall be **(60)** marks, and the total marks for the theoretical side shall be **(40)** marks out of the total grade for the subject.

SECOND // THEORETICAL SUBJECTS:

The final grade for the theoretical subject shall be **(100)** marks, distributed as follows:

- **1. Year's Coursework (Sae'e):** (50) marks.
- **2. Final Examination:** (50) marks.

THIRD // GENERAL PROVISIONS:

1. Scientific departments and subject instructors are committed to applying this mechanism when calculating students' grades.
2. Year's coursework (Sae'e) grades are calculated in accordance with the applicable regulations and instructions issued by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and the University of Anbar.
3. Year's coursework (Sae'e) grades shall be announced to students before the dates of the final examinations according to the specified timings.
4. This mechanism is adopted for all academic stages in the college unless ministerial or university instructions are issued to the contrary.
